



SAFE GENERATOR CONNECTION

Many Southwest Florida residents use portable electric generators to power their homes during electrical outages. While generators are a convenience, if used improperly they can cause hazardous conditions for the homeowner and for electric crews working in the area.

GenerLink™ offered by LCEC eliminates the use of extension cords and other hazardous connections by providing a safe connection from the electric meter directly to the generator. GenerLink™ also detects when a generator is operating and automatically disconnects from the utility grid, eliminating dangerous backfeed.

Questions & Answers...

Q. Do I need a generator in order to use GenerLink™?

A. Yes. GenerLink™ is an interconnection device that enables you to connect your portable generator directly to your home's wiring system. During a power outage, your generator becomes your source of emergency back-up power. GenerLink™ is designed as an alternative to expensive transfer switches and hazardous extension cords.

Q. Where should the generator be placed?

A. Remember: generator exhaust gases contain deadly carbon monoxide. The generator should never be operated inside; this includes basements, crawl spaces, and/or attached garages. Please consult your generator owner's manual for complete instructions on the safe location for and operation of your generator.

Q. What happens if I want GenerLink™ removed from my home?

A. To remove, replace or repair your GenerLink™, you must contact LCEC. Only

LCEC technicians have access to GenerLink™. There is a modest fee for removal of GenerLink™.

Q. What type of maintenance is required for GenerLink™?

A. There is no regular maintenance required for GenerLink™. However, it is recommended that you test your generator every 30-60 days.

Q. Does my electric meter continue to run when using GenerLink™ with my generator?

A. No, your meter will only run when LCEC is providing electric power to your home. When using GenerLink™, with your portable generator, you are automatically disconnected from the electric power supply and will not reconnect until you turn off your generator.
