## Step 1

A heavy-duty suppressor, installed on the main electrical panel by a licensed electrician. This redirects high voltage at the point where it enters the home and helps provide protection for the motors in major household appliances.

## Step 2

Plug-in suppressors installed on smaller and more sensitive appliances and electronics. This helps provide protection for

solid-state equipment such as personal computers, TVs, VCRs, microwaves, and telephones.
