An HRU is an economical, energy-efficient means of heating water. It uses wasted heat from the air conditioning process to heat water. It is good for the environment and can be cost-effective!

The LCEC HRU Program is a partnership formed with local air conditioning contractors to provide HRU installation at a discounted price.

The LCEC HRU PROGRAM DETAILS:

- \$700*- standard installation with existing hot water tank (additional charges may apply)
- Distance between air conditioning system and water heater not to exceed 25 ft. of plumbing
- Minimum of 30 or 40 gallon water tank (not included in package)
- Installed by participating contractor
- Contractor responsible for collecting payment

* LCEC has partnered with local contractors to provide customers with a consistent price. HVAC contractors are solely responsible for scheduling, installing, and providing all costs associated with the installation of the HRU as well as collecting payment of such services.
