- * When cooling your home, set the thermostat at 78 degrees. Each degree below adds 8 to 12 percent to the cooling costs.
- * Set your thermostat at 83 degrees while away from home for more than two hours.
- * Install a programmable thermostat that will automatically raise and lower the temperature at certain times.
- * Turn off fans when the room is not occupied. Each continuously running fan costs approximately \$7 per month on your electric bill.
- * Do not close A/C vents or interior doors when the A/C is running.
- * Change or clean your filters monthly and have your air conditioning system serviced annually.
