The Need for Dual-Stage Protection

LCEC's surgeSENSE surge-protection program is designed to help protect your major appliances from harmful transient voltage surges attempting entry into your home. The program offers two stages of protection.



Whole house SURGE PROTECTION

A transient voltage surge is a very short duration (50 milliseconds) voltage spike of up to 6,000 volts above normal voltage levels. Transient voltage surges can enter your home through the electrical power feed and can also enter via telephone or cable lines.

In Southwest Florida, summer thunderstorms can create increased risk for larger transient surges to attempt entry into a home.
