## MAKE SURE YOUR GENERATOR IS READY.

- Have a regular inspection and testing program in place.
  - Run the generator several times a year
  - For start-up procedures and troubleshooting tips, see the generator owner's manual
- Perform preventive maintenance.
  - Save money and extend equipment life
  - Catch problems before generator failure occurs

Good practices include oil changes and tune-ups following all manufacturers maintenance and operational recommendations.
