Avoid High Bills

- Set thermostat no higher than 68 degrees. Every degree higher raises heating costs 8 percent!
- Invest in a programmable thermostat.
- Layer up! Layers efficiently trap body heat and provide greater comfort.
- Reversing the ceiling fan direction can distribute heat around large rooms.
- Open blinds so the sun can warm the home during the day.
- Sealing leaky ducts can save hundreds of dollars a year!
- Portable space heaters are great for spot heating. Be sure to use space heaters safely!
